Dear Ms. Wilson, Messrs. Grady and Sibley,
I understand that there is no site specific or demolition specific NEPA and SEPA coverage of this proposed action for demolition and "recycling" of asbestos and other hazardous substance laden concrete; or for hazardous and irritant air pollutants and potential runoff pollutants which may impact Lake Washington.

Activities at this sensitive shoreline and heavily populated location require site specific and activity specific impact assessment, rather than relying on a generic EIS for the 520 or other projects which did not consider the specifics related to location or materials. At minimum, review of actual practices and air and runoff mitigation require review with public comment. Those specifics do not appear available with analyses of potential risks and mitigations.

I urge that you conduct the in-depth look pursuant to NEPA and SEPA, with appropriate City and public review and comment on the specifics prior to taking action unless denying at this time due to inadequate review and with mitigation.
